Global Market Outlook

In 2020/21, global total grains production is projected to expand to 2,223m t, up by 2% y/y and an all-time high. This mainly linked to a drop in maize inventories in China, which more than offsets an accumulation of that grain in the USA. Wheat stocks are predicted at an all-time high, led by expansions in China and India. Growth of 2% is envisaged for total grains trade, with shipments of maize, wheat and sorghum accelerating.

World wheat production for 2020-2021 is estimated to be at an all-time record high at 769 million mt, compared with 763 million mt for 2019-2020, largely reflecting the change for India.

Preliminary supply and demand projections for wheat in 2020-21 point to an all-time high for production and a further buildup of stocks, but with inventory growth again concentrated in China and India.

World maize production is projected at consecutive peaks from 2020/21 onwards, reaching 1,177m t by the end of the forecast period, up by 9% from the estimate for 2018/19. Medium term growth is likely to be led by productivity gains, albeit a little slower than recently, but total area is also seen trending higher, at an average of about 1% p.a

Global rice production is seen unchanged at 499 million tonnes in 2019-20 but is forecast to rise to 509 million tonnes in the upcoming marketing year, the IGC said. Consumption rose 1% to 495 million tonnes in 2019-20 and is expected to rise another 1% to 501 million tonnes in 2021.

World corn harvested area in 2020-2021 is tentatively seen growing by 1%, mainly on a rebound in the US

Global soybean area for harvesting to rise 4% on the year in 2020-2021 because of an expected rebound in the US.

Wheat prices have gone up after a price drop in March. Rice has become more expensive, and corn has lost market due to decreased interest in biofuels. Companies are stockpiling grains and pulses, and consumers are hoarding all kinds of easy-to-store products. The COVID-19 pandemic is changing market dynamics.
